1. City tour of Mumbai :

AM : Excursion to Elephanta caves by ferry. The Elephanta Caves are a great tourist attraction in the vicinity of the large **Mumbai** metropolis. The Elephanta island is located 10 km away from the Gateway of India at Mumbai. These caves house rock cut temples dating back to the 5th century CE.

PM : Half day city tour of Mumbai. The western state of Maharashtra is home to Bombay, India's greatest port, financial capital and trend-setting East-West nexus. Perched on the Arabian Sea on an island and separated from the rest of India by a winding creek, Bombay, now known as Mumbai, is a world unto itself, with a unique intensity that hits you the moment you land. 2. Overnight trip to Aurangabad :

The caves at Ajanta are all Buddhist, while the caves at Ellora are a mixture of Buddhist, Hindu and Jain.
